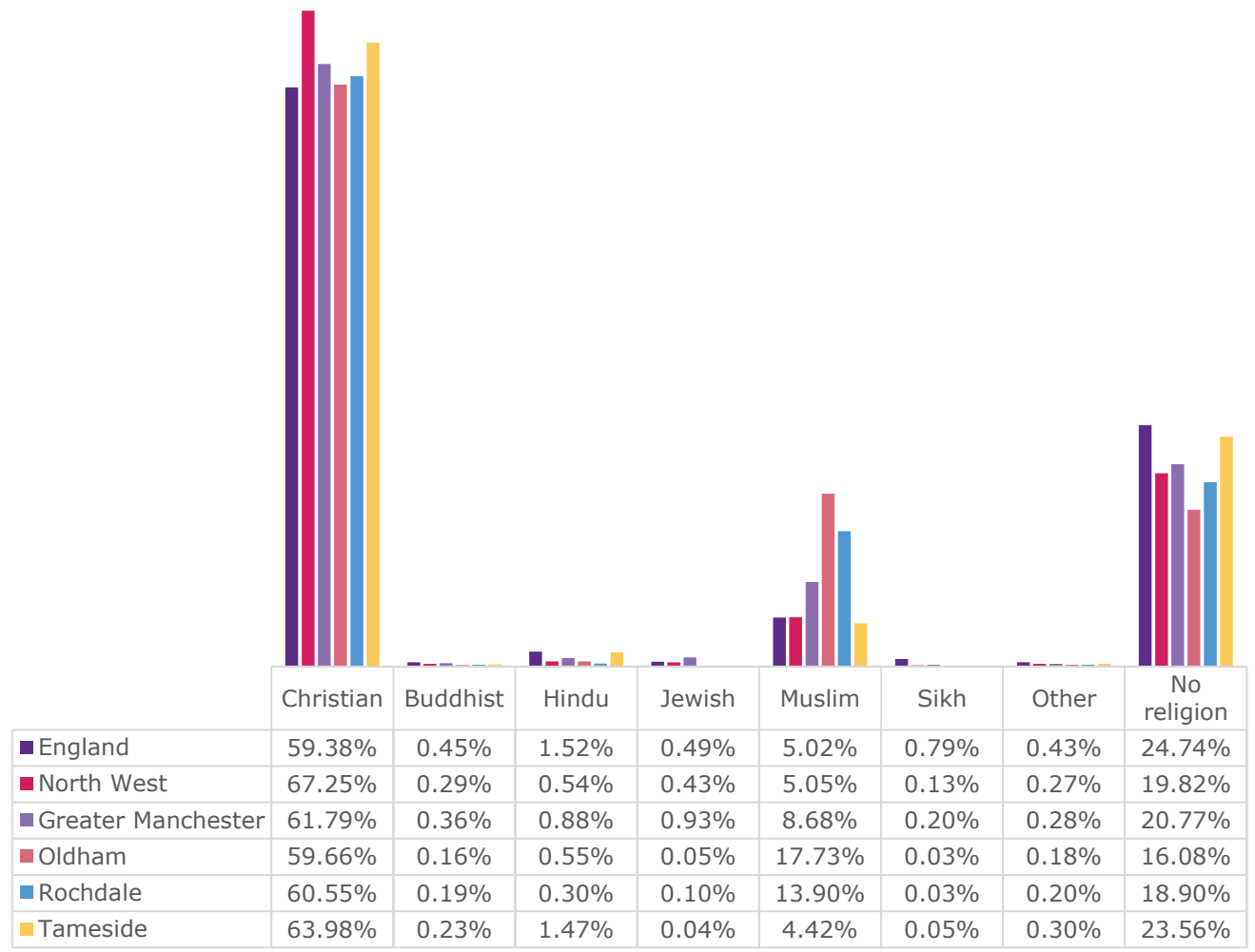

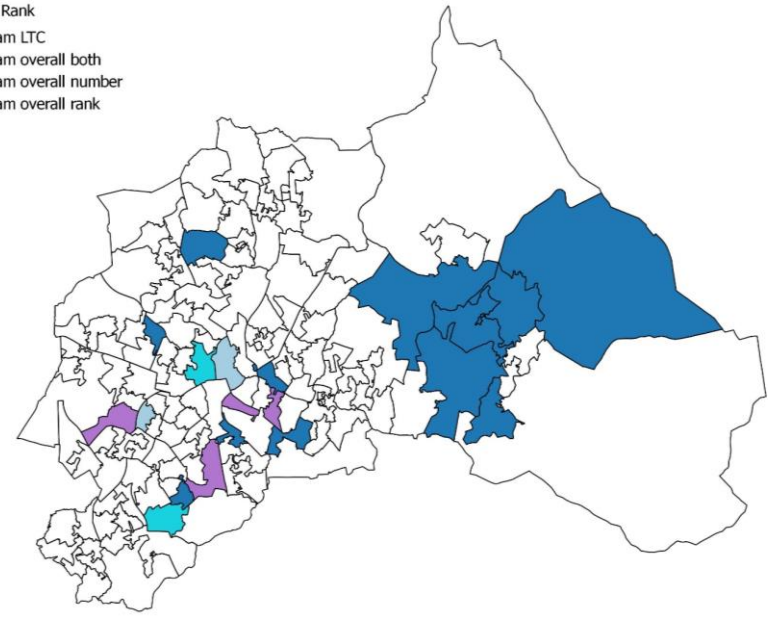

HOW MANY ORGANISATIONS IN THE VCSE SECTOR?

There are an estimated 15,890 organisations in GM, 77% are micro organisations with an income below £10,000

1,231 ORGANISATIONS IN OLDHAM (274 REGISTERED)

70% MICRO ORGANISATIONS

28,800 VOLUNTEERS

2,200 FTE PAID STAFF

1.8 MILLION INTERVENTIONS

32% IN SPORT AND LEISURE

ORGANISATIONS IDENTIFYING OLDHAM AS KEY AREA:

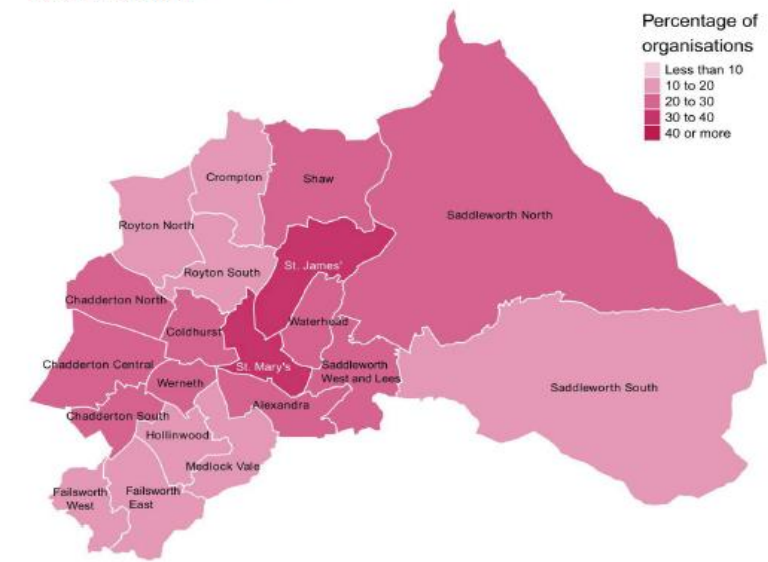
One third identified St James' or St Mary's as a main focus of their work.

The two wards which were a main focus for the lowest proportion of Oldham organisations were:

- Royton South (12 per cent)
- Failsworth East (12 per cent).

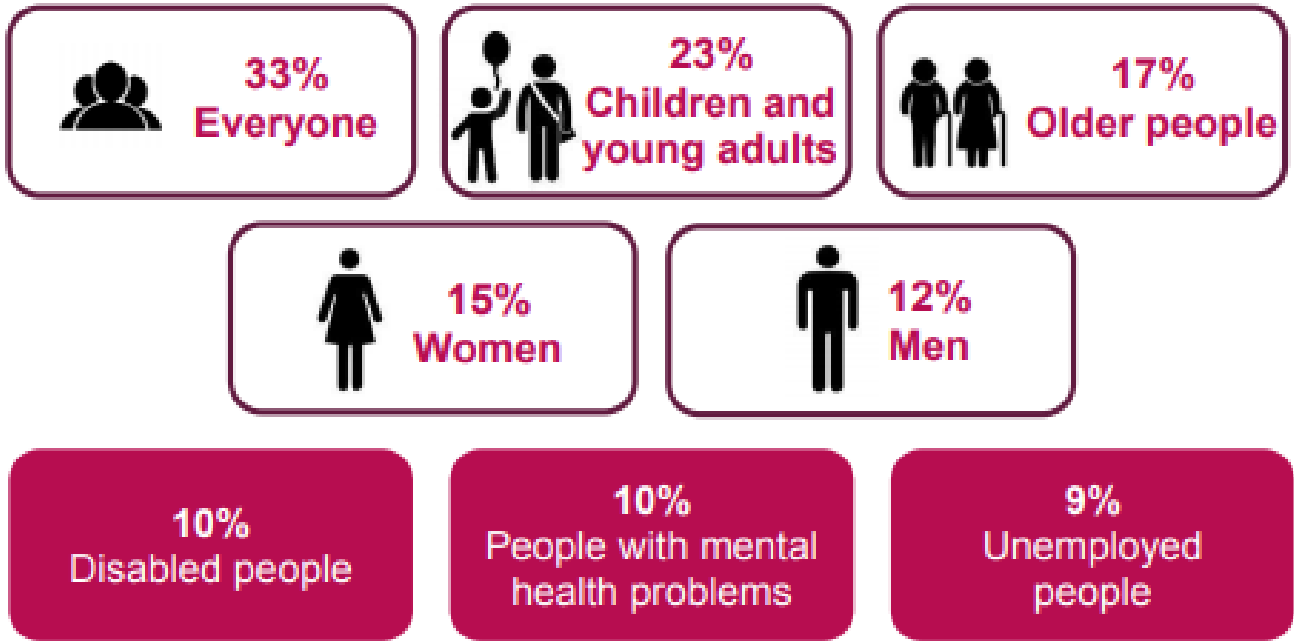
Map 4.1: Percentage of organisations that identify Oldham's wards as a main focus of their work

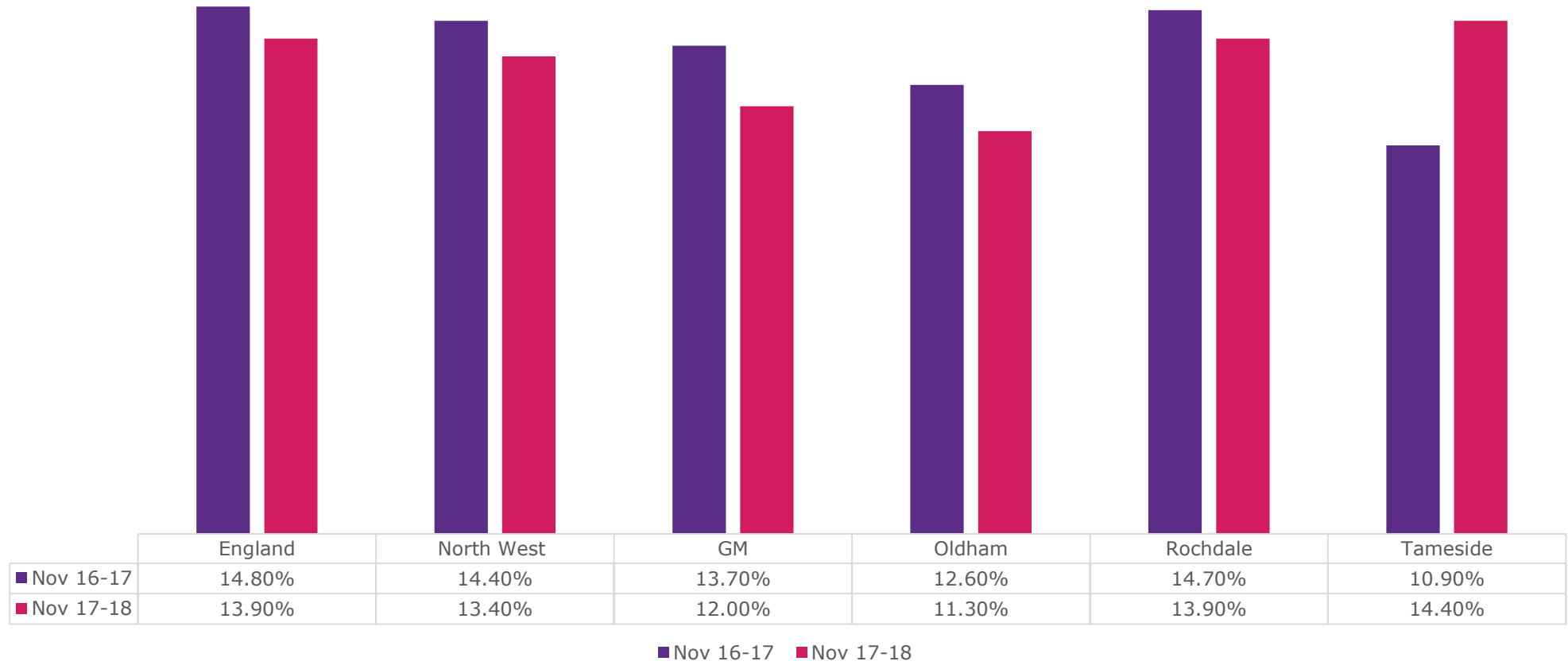

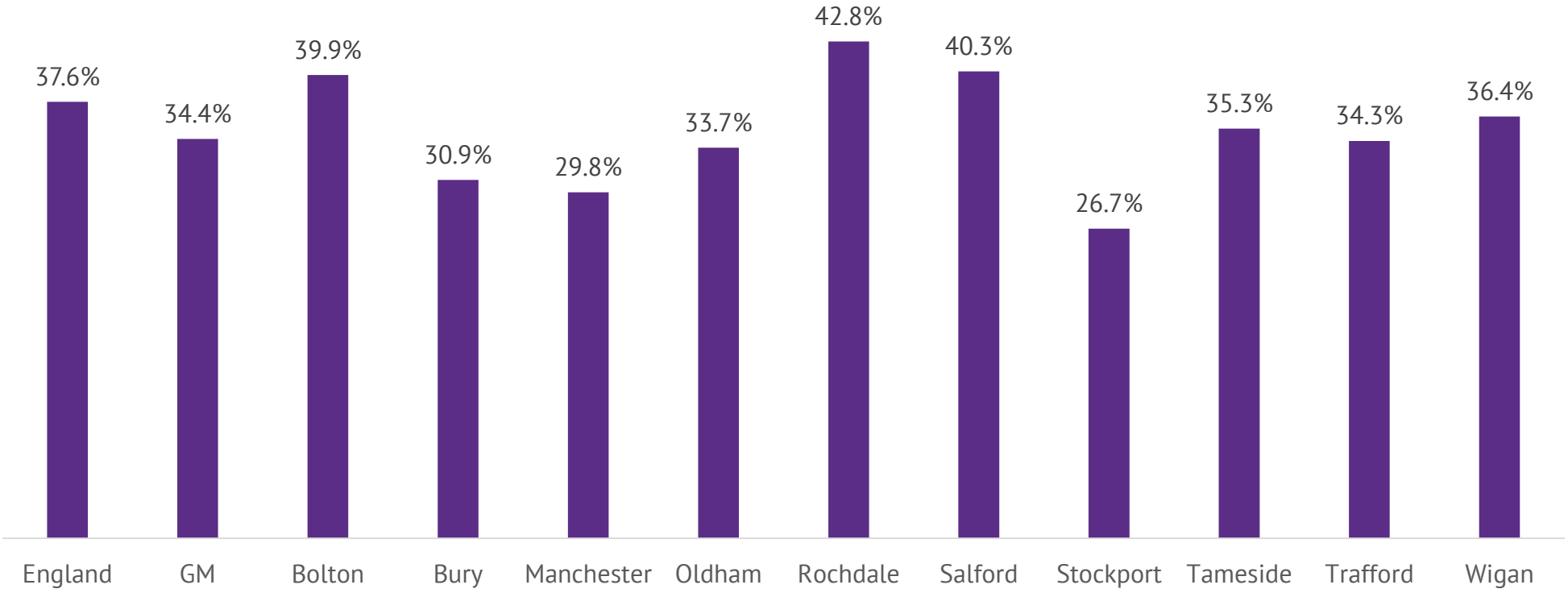

KEY POINTS

FAILSWORTH EAST - AREA

The lowest proportion of organisations focus on this area (12%). This area has high inactivity and high levels of obesity at the end of year 6. This is an area high in inequalities, and few organisations operate in this area.

LONG TERM HEALTH CONDITIONS/ DISABILITY

In Oldham there are high levels of premature mortality per 100k people. 102.7 premature Mortality for Cancer compared to 79.4, 77.3 premature mortality for CVD compared to 46.7 And 26.7 premature mortality for respiratory disease compared to 18.6. Only 14% of organisations focus on older people and 10% focus on those with a disability.

ETHNICITY/ FAITH GROUPS

8% of current VCSE organisations operate in Faith Groups, of those who benefit from the work, 9% Are from ethnic backgrounds. Oldham has high levels of BAME residents. Within Oldham 17.7% of residents are Muslim, which is higher than both England and GM. The Asian population is 19.2%.
