



WIGAN POPULATION & PROJECTIONS







KEY POINTS

LOW SOCIO-ECONOMIC GROUPS

Those from low socio-economic backgrounds are less likely to do any kind of volunteering than those in higher socio-economic backgrounds. 38% of Wigan residents are in the NS SEC 6-8. 6.9% of young people in Wigan are NEET.

MENTAL HEALTH / DISABILITY

21.5% of people in Wigan (highest across GM) have a Disability and 21.6% have high anxiety. 13% of current organisations in the VCSE sector focus on people poor mental health and 11% on those with a disability.

OLDER PEOPLE

People 75+ are the least likely to volunteer, only 16% of organisations in the VCSE sector currently target older people. Premature mortality is high in Wigan compared to England for CVD, cancer and respiratory disease and there are 2820 hospital admissions due to falls each year. Population projections show there are going to be more older people by 2021. Less people in this age group are active and tend to volunteer in the sport and physical activity sector.
